

SUPREME COURT OF LOUISIANA

ORDER

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the 1974 Louisiana Constitution, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the need to amend the rules of this Court,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

Part 1. Louisiana Supreme Court Rule XXXV, Section 1, **third sentence**, be and is hereby amended to read:

RULE XXXV, Judicial Campaign Oversight Committee

Section 1. Composition; General Duties; Terms of Office.

* * *

One of the judge or lawyer members shall be designated by the Court to chair the work of the Committee.

* * *

Part 2. Louisiana Supreme Court Rule XXXV, Section 6, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6. Political Involvement in Elections.

Members of the Judicial Campaign Oversight Committee shall be regulated and constrained in their political activities, in the

same fashion as judges and judicial candidates, by Canon 7 of
the Louisiana Code of Judicial Conduct.

This Order shall become effective upon signing and shall remain in full force
and effect thereafter unless amended or changed under the authority of future orders of this
Court.
