Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, the inherent power of this Court, and Article 253.2 of the Louisiana Code of Civil Procedure,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

Part G, Section 12(C) of the Supreme Court General Administrative Rules be and is hereby promulgated to read as follows:

**Section 12. Reassignment Procedures.**

**C. Reassignment of Cases In the 21st Judicial District Court**

In the event the 21st Judicial District Court establishes two juvenile divisions in accordance with Rule XXXIII of the rules of this Court, 5% of the civil and adult criminal cases pending in the new juvenile divisions may be randomly reassigned to the non-juvenile divisions of court, and 5% of future civil and adult criminal cases which are allotted to the juvenile divisions may be randomly reassigned to the non-juvenile divisions of court.

This Order shall become effective upon signing, and shall remain in full force and effect thereafter, until amended through future orders of this Court.
