ORDER

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the 1974 Louisiana Constitution, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the need to amend Section 30 of the Rules for Lawyer Disciplinary Enforcement,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

Louisiana Supreme Court Rule XIX, Section 30C be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 30. Appeal by Complainant.**


C. **To the Court.** Within thirty days of the mailing of the disciplinary board disposition of the complainant's appeal, the complainant may file a petition for leave to appeal to the court. Leave shall not be granted unless the complainant shows that the board acted arbitrarily, capriciously, or unreasonably.

The board shall include in the record the date the disposition of the complainant's appeal was mailed.


This rule shall become effective upon signing and shall remain in full force and effect unless amended or changed under the authority of future orders of this Court.
