

Matthew Stubenberg graduated from the University of Maryland Baltimore County in 2009, and graduated *cum laude* from Maryland Law School in 2013. Interested in using technology to change how the law is practiced, he set out to develop his first legal based app. The app named, *Not Guilty App* was a directory of Court resources and Judges in Maryland. The app was downloaded several hundred times and was a finalist for the Legaltech Innovation Awards in 2015. Matthew then moved on to create *MDExpungement.com*, a website that automates the expungement process and has been used to expunge more than 14,000 cases since launching in 2015.

Matthew worked as a law clerk for the Honorable Judge Goetzke in Anne Arundel and then as Sr. Application Specialist for the Maryland Legal Aid Bureau. Matthew is currently the IT Director at the Maryland Volunteer Lawyers Service (MVLS). Hi most recent project is building the *CLUE* program which will automatically search public databases to find potential legal issues for clients of MVLS.
