The PC

THE PC IS:

- DESIGNED FOR USE BY A HUMAN
- USES AN OPERATING SYSTEM TO INTERFACE BETWEEN THE HUMAN USER AND THE MICROPROCESSOR
- EQUIPPED WITH CERTAIN
 COMMON INTERNAL COMPONENTS
- RUNNING SOFTWARE APPLICATIONS
 DESIGNED FOR USE BY THE HUMAN USER
- ABLE TO ADD/REMOVE HARDWARE OR SOFTWARE AS NEEDED




Simple Peer-to-Peer Network




