Brianne A. Hemmans is a native of New Orleans, Louisiana, and a Dean's List graduate of Louisiana State University, where she obtained a Bachelor of Science, with a concentration in pre-law and a minor in Spanish, her native language. Brianne first obtained bar admission in Florida in 2004, where she worked as an Associate Attorney in the litigation department at Lowndes, Drosdick, Doster, Kantor and Reed, a large firm based in Central Florida, before returning home to Louisiana. Brianne was licensed by the Louisiana State Bar in 2005 and thereafter served as a Staff Attorney for fifteen years to the Honorable Alvin Turner, Jr. at the 23rd Judicial District Court. In March of 2020, Brianne joined the Office of the Disciplinary Counsel in Louisiana. Brianne heads the monitoring department, where her duties are focused primarily on managing the conditional admission and probation responsibilities of the office. In addition to managing the probation department, Brianne conducts investigations and prosecutes disciplinary cases.

Brianne is also an adjunct professor at the Southern University Law Center, where she has taught both common and civil law bar prep courses to 3L students. Brianne has also worked as an instructor with the Pre-Law program.
