


Bridging Divides, Celebrating Differences

John C. Brittain is the Olie W. Rauh Professor of Law at the David A. Clarke University of the District of Columbia School of Law. He holds the position of professor emeritus at UConn Law School. In addition, he served as dean of the Thurgood Marshall School of Law at Texas Southern University, chief counsel of the Lawyers' Committee for Civil Rights Under Law in Washington, DC, president of the National Lawyers' Guild, member of the ACLU National Board of Directors and the Executive Committee, National Counsel of Black Lawyers, and legal counsel to the NAACP at the local level and national office of the General Counsel. The NAACP honored John with the prestigious William Robert Ming Advocacy Award for legal service to the NAACP without a fee. And finally, Professor Brittain continues as a licensed lawyer for 53 years.
