Speaker Biography



Nicholas Hite is a Senior Attorney with Lambda Legal where he participates in a variety of nationwide impact litigation in state and federal courts on behalf of LGBTQ+ people and people living with HIV/AIDS. Prior to joining Lambda, Nicholas established The Hite Law Group in New Orleans, Louisiana and practiced there for 10 years. The Hite Law Group was the only openly queer-run, queer-centered law firm in Louisiana. As a solo practitioner, Nicholas served over 3,000 clients across all 43 district courts in Louisiana, providing leading-edge legal services for LGBTQ+identified clients, especially adult and child survivors of intimate partner violence and sexual assault. Instrumental in spearheading policy and practice changes for transgender and gender nonconforming (TGNC) Louisianans making ID corrections more accessible, Nicholas is the sole TGNCcompetent legal resource in Louisiana recognized by the Transgender Legal Services Network, Transgender Law Center, and Transgender Legal Defense and Education Fund. He also served as a juvenile public defender, co-founder and managing attorney for the non-profit Family Justice Legal Center, and legal counsel for the New Orleans Family Justice Alliance. In 2022, Nicholas was recognized as one of the 40 Best LGBTQ+ Lawyers Under 40 by the national LGBTQ+ Bar Association and in 2023 received the Hostetter-Habib Family Award from Family Equality. Nicholas has appeared on several podcasts and radio broadcasts and his work has been profiled in Nola.com/The Advocate, The Washington Post, and People Magazine.
