Shadowing opportunities open for 2018 "Suit Up for the Future" program

he Louisiana State Bar Association, in partnership with the Louisiana Bar Foundation and Just the Beginning, will host the next "Suit Up for the Future" program from June 11-29. The free, three-week legal institute for high school students offers an abridged law school session, field trips to

law schools and courts, and an internship consisting of shadowing at area law offices and courts.

Shadowing opportunities are still available during the second week of the program (June 18-22). Students are assigned to "shadow" attorneys at firms, courts and organizations. This gives the students the

opportunity to witness what attorneys do on a daily basis and to spend one-on-one time with attorneys in the workplace.
