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Paul M. Smith is a Visiting Professor from Practice at Georgetown Law School, where he teaches, among other courses, a seminar called Topics in LGBTQ Civil Rights. He was previously a partner at the law firm of Jenner & Block, where he chaired the firm's Appellate & Supreme Court Practice. He has argued 21 cases in the U.S. Supreme Court including the landmark gay rights case, *Lawrence v. Texas* (2003). Paul attended Amherst College and Yale Law School. He was a law clerk for Supreme Court Justice Lewis F. Powell Jr.
