Susan StVincent is the first chief operating officer at Legal Aid Foundation of Los Angeles (LAFLA), where she supervises the IT, facilities and human resources departments. Her goal is to improve interdepartmental collaboration and make LAFLA a better place to work for all staff.

StVincent joined LAFLA in 2019 as managing attorney for client intake, overseeing multi-channel intake across all LAFLA offices. More recently, as managing attorney for data and innovation, she has been responsible for LegalServer administration, conducting technology trainings, streamlining business processes with program staff, creating reports and data visualizations to support data-informed decision-making, building grant tracking and reporting tools, and managing technology projects.

Before joining LAFLA, StVincent served as director of legal programs at Christian Legal Aid of Los Angeles. She also worked as a court-appointed mediator in the High Court of Uganda, advised the Supreme Court of Rwanda on case management and alternative dispute resolution, and volunteered as a mediator in Los Angeles small claims courts.

She holds both a Juris Doctor and a Master of Dispute Resolution from Pepperdine School of Law.
