

Members Certified Elected for Leadership Positions; 1 Runoff Set

Several LSBA members have been certified elected for leadership positions on the Board of Governors, Nominating Committee, Young Lawyers Division Council and the American Bar Association House of Delegates, following the close of first-round voting on Nov. 18. One runoff election is scheduled.
