

2019 MCLE EXEMPTION STATEMENT

- _____ I was a member of the United States Armed Forces on active duty throughout 2019 (Rule 2(3)).
- _____ Meeting the mandatory continuing legal education requirements would have worked an undue hardship upon me in 2019 because (describe the mitigating circumstances as specifically as possible and enclose additional sheets of supporting information (Rule 2(2)). Financial hardship is not considered grounds for exemption. Please contact the MCLE Department if you require assistance in locating low cost programming.
- _____ My home and/or office at _____ suffered substantial damage due to a natural disaster in 2019. I am requesting an exemption for this year.
