

ORDER

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the need to amend the Rules for Continuing Legal Education,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

1. Louisiana Supreme Court Rule XXX, Rule 2, Section 5 be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

(5) All Members who have attained the age of sixty-five (65) years, except Louisiana state court judges who have attained the age of 65 shall be required to complete 5 hours of CLE annually from programs sponsored by the Louisiana Judicial College.

2. Louisiana Supreme Court Rule XXX, Rule 3(f) be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

(f) Louisiana state court judges shall be required to earn a minimum of 5 of the 12.5 hours of CLE required annually from programs sponsored by the Louisiana Judicial College, starting on January 1 of the year following their election to judicial office. A Louisiana state court judge who has attained the age of sixty-five (65) years shall only be required to earn 5 hours of CLE annually from programs sponsored by the Louisiana Judicial College.

* * * * *

These rule changes shall become effective upon signing, and shall remain in full force and effect thereafter, until amended or changed through future orders of this Court.
