

SUPREME COURT OF LOUISIANA

ORDER

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the need to amend the Rules for Continuing Legal Education,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

1. Louisiana Supreme Court Rule XXX, Rule 5 be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

RULE 5. ANNUAL REPORT

(a) On or before December 1 of each calendar year, the MCLE Committee will email each member a preliminary report of compliance with the MCLE requirements for that year. The report will be emailed to the Members' email address on file with the LSBA.

(b) Hours completed in any year in excess of the minimum number may be carried forward to satisfy the requirements for the year next following.

(c) On or before March 15 the MCLE Committee will forward to each non-complying Member via email a final transcript of compliance for the preceding calendar year. Such members shall correct any error(s) in the final transcript by forwarding to the MCLE Committee a written explanation of any such error(s) by March 31. Members whose transcripts reflect compliance with the MCLE requirements of

this Rule shall not receive a copy of their final transcript, but shall receive email notification reflecting such compliance.

2. The first two sentences of Louisiana Supreme Court Rule XXX, Regulations/Rule 5, Regulation 5.1(a) be and are hereby amended to read as follows:

REGULATIONS/RULE 5

Regulation 5.1. (a) On or before December 1 of each calendar year, the MCLE Department shall email to each member a reminder of the compliance deadline and a link to view his or her transcript online. The report shall list his or her current record of compliance for that year.

* * * *

This rule change shall become effective upon signing, and shall remain in full force and effect thereafter, until amended or changed through future orders of this Court.
