ORDER

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the recommendation of the Louisiana State Bar Association that the voluntary mentoring program previously established by this Court on May 15, 2013, and amended on February 23, 2017, be continued for an additional two years,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

- 1. The voluntary mentoring program designated as the Transition Into Practice program established by this Court on May 15, 2013, and expanded to include new Bar admittees statewide by Order of this Court dated February 23, 2017, is hereby extended for an additional two years, until December 31, 2020.
- 2. All other provisions of the Court's May 15, 2013 Order and February 23, 2017 Order continue in effect.
