

BICENTENNIAL OF THE LOUISIANA SUPREME COURT

In order to celebrate the bicentennial of Louisiana's Supreme Court, we are sponsoring a celebration of Louisiana's rich legal heritage demonstrated by tributes to four former Supreme Court Justices, Martin, Tate, Dennis and Calogero. These four justices were and are heroes of the Civil Law in Louisiana. By their intelligence and determination, they each played essential roles in applying the doctrines and methodology of the Civil Law to produce the rich Louisiana legal tradition of today. LSU law professor Olivier Moreteau will present a talk on Francois Xavier Martin and a historical overview of the court. Justice Albert Tate's storied career as a jurist will be discussed by Grover Joseph Rees, United States Ambassador (Retired), in a talk entitled "Judge Albert Tate and Louisiana Exceptionalism." Chief Justice Pascal F. Calogero Jr.'s many contributions to the civil law in Louisiana will be discussed. Judge James L. Dennis will speak on his tenure on the Supreme Court and his role in relocating the court to the present location. Louis R. Koerner, Jr. will moderate the symposium. Following the event, a reception will be held featuring Louisiana musicians performing songs from the 20th century – in French and English.
