ORDER

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the recommendation of the Louisiana State Bar Association that the voluntary mentoring program previously established by this Court on May 15, 2013, be continued and expanded for new Bar admittees,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

- The voluntary mentoring program designated as the Transition
 Into Practice program established by this Court on May 15,
 2013, is hereby extended for an additional two years, until
 December 31, 2018. The program is expanded to include new
 Bar admittees statewide.
- 2. All other provisions of the Court's May 15, 2013 Order continue in effect.
