**RE: LBLs Employment Law and Labor Law Specializations**


Dear Counsel:

The Louisiana Board of Legal Specialization (“LBLs” or “Board”) is looking for interested members of the bar who would be willing to serve on either the 2022-2023 Employment Law or Labor Law Advisory Commissions. The advisory commissions are composed of up to nine (9) members who actively administer the programs in either Employment Law or Labor Law in cooperation with and under the general policy guidance of the Louisiana Board of Legal Specialization. Your participation would be purely voluntary as the Louisiana Board of Legal Specialization is not permitted to compensate its members. If you have previously applied for a position on either the 2021-2022 Employment Law and/or Labor Law Advisory Commissions, kindly advise if you are still interested in serving on the 2022-2023 Advisory Commission.

The LSBA House of Delegates and Board of Governors approved revised Employment Law Standards and Labor Law Standards at their annual meeting in June 2021.
