- 2. Motions to **amend pleadings** to be filed <u>30 days from today</u>.
- 3. Plaintiff(s) to file a **final** list of **expert witness(es)** in chief and submit expert reports to defendant(s) by <u>02/15/2020</u>.* Defendant(s) to file a **final** list of **expert witness(es)** in chief and submit **expert reports** to plaintiff(s) by <u>03/01/2020</u>.
- 4. Plaintiff(s) to file a **final** list of **witness(es)** together with addresses and brief summary of expected testimony where a witness has not already been deposed by 03/01/2020.*

5. Plaintiff(s) to file a final exhibit list by: 03/01/2020.* Defendant(s) to file objections to plaintiff(s) final exhibit list, under Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(3)(B) by 03/15/2020.

Defendant(s) to file a final exhibit list and any exhibits not previously submitted by 04/01/2020.* Plaintiff(s) to file objections to defendant(s) final exhibit list, under Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(2)(3)(B) by 04/15/2020.

*The listing of witnesses and exhibits shall be separately state those expected to be called or used and those which may be called or used if the need arises. Except for good cause shown, no witness will be permitted to testify and no exhibit will be admitted in any party's case in chief unless such

The interval between the dispositive motion deadline (¶ 6) and trial docket (¶ 7) is relatively inflexible. An extension of time to file or respond to a motion for summary judgment will likely affect the trial setting.
